









Patient and Family Engagement (throughout episode of care)

All patients receive
Universal Screening
with the C-SSRS screen



COMPREHENSIVE SUICIDE RISK
ASSESSMENT, including risk &
protective factors and access to lethal
means

Risk Level Determination

High – Moderate – Low

Suicide Care Management Plan - INPATIENT

All receive **Universal Precautions**:

Psychoeducation regarding fluidity of risk + Lifeline & Got5 Crisis Text Line numbers

Ideation with intent in past 90 days, or suicidal behavior in the past year ("Yes" To C-SSRS Questions 4,5,6 and/or 7 OR according to clinical judgment):

TREATMENT PLAN
with goals and objectives that target
suicide, including a plan for
two **foreseeable** changes

Stanley-Brown SAFETY PLAN (with lethal means reduction counseling)

WARM HAND-OFF OF RECORDS Forward records prior to first visit, including discharge summary, Safety Plan & 2 foreseeable changes

STRUCTURED FOLLOW-UP PHONE CALL w/in 24-72 hours of discharge

Non-demand Caring Contacts w/in 2 weeks & 3 months of discharge

High Risk: Universal Precautions + Care pathway elements are required

Moderate Risk: Universal Precautions + Care pathway elements are strongly recommended

Low Risk: Universal Precautions only
